

Jewelry or Sewing Pouch

Supplies

- 3/8 yard cotton fabric
- Matching thread
- 2 ½ yds. ¼" ribbon
- Freezer paper cut into 3 squares
- 1 – 13" square
- 1 – 10" square
- 1 – 5" square
- Paper clips
- Small safety pin

Trace the 2 circle wedges and the small half circle on paper.

Mark lines on small circle. Cut out.

1. Fold large and medium freezer paper squares into quarters. Fold small square in half.
 2. Lay patterns on freezer paper. Match straight edges with fold lines. Hold in place with paper clip. Trace curved edge.
 3. Leave squares paper clipped together and cut along curved lines. Unfold and you should have 3 circles.
 4. Trace straight lines on dull side of small circle, marking them all the way across. Set aside for later use as a stitching guide.
 5. Fold the fabric in half right sides together.
 6. Lay large and medium freezer paper circles on fabric, shiny side down. Keep circles at least 1" apart and ½" from fabric edge. Iron freezer paper templates to fabric. Pin through fabric and paper layers.
 7. Cut circles apart, leaving at least ½" around each.
 8. Stitch next to freezer paper circles. Remove pins.
 9. Mark an X in the centers of the freezer paper templates.
 10. Cut circles out ¼" away from stitching line.
 11. Pull fabric layers apart on each circle. Snip on X being careful not to cut into bottom of circle fabric. Peel off freezer paper.
 12. Turn the circles right side out through the X's. Shake circles.
 13. Insert a point turner into the circles through the X's. Push out the edges with the point turner, making them smooth. Press.
 14. Iron the large and medium circles into fourths to find the exact center.
 15. Place the small freezer paper circle on top of the medium circle (the side without the X). Match the centers, iron the freezer paper.
 16. With a pencil and a ruler, extend the lines on the freezer paper to the edges of the fabric circle.

1. Place this circle over the large circle with the X sides together. Match the centers and fold lines. Pin.
 2. Stitch around the small freezer paper circle. Stitch across all of the lines to the outside edge of the medium circle. Backstitch at each end. This creates the pockets. Peel off freezer paper.
 3. On the outside of the large circle mark and cut 2 small slits between the casing lines directly across from each other. Cut through one layer of fabric only. Use small scissors or a seam ripper.
 4. Cut ribbon in half. Pin safety pin to one end of ribbon. Starting at on slit, push the safety pin through the casing all the way around the circle to the same slit. Tie ribbon ends together. Do not gather circle, try to keep flat.
 5. Pin safety pin to second slit and push safety pin through casing all the way around the circle. Keep the circle flat. Remove safety pin. Tie ribbon ends together.
 6. Pull the ribbons to close bag. Adjust gathers. Fill the jewelry pouch with treasures!
