

## Travel Size Tissue Holder

### Supplies:

Main fabric – 8 1/2" x 9"

Main fabric backing (can be muslin you will not see it) – 8 1/2" x 9"

Lining fabric – 7" x 8"

Batting - 8 1/2" x 9"

### Quilting the fabrics for the travel size tissue holder:

Cut main fabric and main fabric backing 1- 8 1/2" x 9"

Cut batting 1- 8 1/2" x 9"

1. Layer main fabric backing wrong side up. Place batting on top of backing, then place main fabric on top of batting right side up.
2. Machine quilt as desired. We cross-hatched diagonally. Draw a line from one corner to the opposite corner diagonally. Repeat for other diagonal. Machine quilt on one of the drawn lines. Place sewing machine seam guide in sewing machine (following machine instruction book) set the seam guide for 1" from the 1<sup>st</sup> sewn line. Stitch keeping the seam guide on the previous stitched line. Continue until the whole side is quilted. Repeat for other side until the whole rectangle is quilted.

### Sewing the travel size tissue holder:

1. Trim the quilted piece to 7" x 8". Cut 1 – 7" x 8" rectangle from the lining fabric.
2. With right sides together using a 1/4" seam allowance around all 4 edges leaving a 4" opening on one of the 8" sides for turning.
3. Trim corners and press open seam allowance on the side of the opening only. (This will make it easier for stitching later)
4. Turn right side out through opening. Push all corners out with a point turner tool and press well.
5. Fold in half so it measures 4". Press a crease to mark center.
6. Open back up and fold each short end (lining side up) to the center crease line. Overlap the ends 3/8". Pin and stitch side seams securely. We stitched them 3 times. Turn right side out and press. Insert your tissues and enjoy. They make great gifts!
